MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Gabriel S. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Dover-Foxcroft, Stitham, J.) terminating her parental rights. Contrary to the mother's contentions, (1) the court's factual findings reflect that it undertook a critical and independent assessment of all the evidence presented at the hearing, see In re Marpheen C., 2002 ME 170, ¶ 7, 812 A.2d 972, 974, and (2) there is evidence in the record to support the court's findings of at least one ground of unfitness and that termination of the mother's parental rights is in the child's best interest, see In re Robert S., 2009 ME 18, ¶ 15, 966 A.2d 894, 898.
