MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kerry I. Hearod appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Mills, J.*) finding him guilty, following a jury trial, of operating under the influence (Class D), 29-A M.R.S. § 2411(1-A)(B)(1) (2009), and operating in violation of a condition or restriction on a license (Class E), 29-A M.R.S. § 1251(1)(B) (2009). On appeal, Hearod argues only that there was insufficient evidence to support a finding that he was guilty of operating under the influence. Viewing the evidence in the record most favorably to the jury's finding of guilt, *see State v. Bickart*, 2009 ME 7, ¶ 46, 963 A.2d 183, 195, the evidence is sufficient to support the verdict.
