## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Marie Lane, Rosa Lane, Debra Larrabee, and Anthony Kurlovich (collectively, Lane) appeal from the judgment of the Superior Court (Knox County, *Hjelm, J.*) that denied their M.R. Civ. P. 60(b) motion for relief from an earlier judgment in a land dispute. Contrary to Lane's contentions, the court did not err or abuse its discretion in concluding that Lane's opposition was untimely. *See* M.R. Civ. P. 7(c)(2); *Scott Dugas Trucking & Excavating, Inc. v. Homeplace Bldg.* & *Remodeling, Inc.*, 651 A.2d 327, 329 (Me. 1994) (holding that the additional time provided for service by mail is inapplicable when a party is required to act within a prescribed period after the date of an order); *City of Lewiston v. Me. State Employees Ass'n*, 638 A.2d 739, 742 (Me. 1994).
