MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Allison M. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Goranites, J.*) terminating her parent rights to the child pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1) (2009). Contrary to the mother's contentions, any error in admitting into evidence the social worker's report as a business record was harmless. *See State v. Gorman*, 2004 ME 90, ¶¶ 41, 51, 54-55, 854 A.2d 1164, 1174, 1176-78. Additionally, the mother's due process rights were not violated, *see In re Misty B.*, 2000 ME 67, ¶¶ 8-9, 749 A.2d 754, 757, and there exists sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's findings of parental unfitness and that termination of the mother's parental rights was in the child's best interests. *See In re Robert S.*, 2009 ME 18, ¶ 15, 966 A.2d 894, 898; *In re Thomas H.*, 2005 ME 123, ¶ 16, 889 A.2d 297, 301.
