MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Dennis J. Finnemore appeals from a judgment of conviction for assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 207(1)(A) (2010), entered in the District Court (Presque Isle, O'Mara, J.) following a bench trial. Contrary to Finnemore's contentions, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for the court to rationally find that the State had disproved every element of self-defense beyond a reasonable doubt. See 17-A M.R.S. §§ 101(1), 108(1) (2010); State v. Michaud, 1998 ME 251, ¶ 19, 724 A.2d 1222, 1230.
