## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Dakota W. appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Bangor, *Gunther*, *J.*) terminating his parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a), (b)(ii) (2010). Contrary to the father's contentions, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support, by clear and convincing evidence, the court's findings of parental unfitness and that termination of the father's parental rights was in the best interest of the child. *See In re Robert S.*, 2009 ME 18, ¶ 15, 966 A.2d 894, 898.
