MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Kiiya F. and Asa H. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (South Paris, *Stanfill*, *J*.) terminating her parental rights to the children. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055 (2010). Contrary to the mother's contentions, (1) the court did not err in entering a jeopardy order that established permanency plans for the children and directed the Department of Health and Human Services to cease reunification efforts with the mother because two prior placements with her had failed and continued reunification efforts would be inconsistent with the permanency plans for the children, *see* 22 M.R.S. § 4041(2)(A-2) (2010), and (2) the court acted within its discretion in addressing the mother's requests for discovery sanctions, *see In re Misty B.*, 2000 ME 67, ¶ 9, 749 A.2d 754.
