MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Arbitrators from the Bangor Board of Realtors awarded an \$8200 commission from a home sale to David Sleeper. Scott Ruffner appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Anderson, J.*) confirming the Board's award against him. Sleeper cross-appeals from the Superior Court's award of less than the entire amount of contractual attorney fees he requested. We discern no error of fact or law in the Superior Court's decision that the statutory grounds for vacating an arbitration award were not present in this case. *See* 14 M.R.S. § 5938 (2010); *HL 1, LLC v. Riverwalk, LLC*, 2011 ME 29, ¶ 28, 15 A.3d 725. Further, the trial court correctly enforced the parties' contractual agreement in awarding attorney fees, and it did not abuse its discretion in awarding less than the amount Sleeper requested. *See Cheung v. Wu*, 2007 ME 22, ¶ 24, 919 A.2d 619 (citing *St. Hilaire & Assocs., Inc. v. Harbor Corp.*, 607 A.2d 905, 906-07 (Me. 1992)).
