MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Natalia, Aleigha, and Isaiah R. appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Bangor, *Soucy, J.*) terminating his parental rights to his three children pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2010). On appeal, the father contends that the evidence is insufficient to support the findings justifying termination of parental rights to the clear and convincing evidence standard. The evidence before the court was more than sufficient to find, to the clear and convincing evidence standard, both parental unfitness and that the best interests of the children were served by termination of the father's parental rights. *See In re Cody T.*, 2009 ME 95, ¶ 28, 979 A.2d 81, 85; *In re Marcus S.*, 2007 ME 24, ¶ 7, 916 A.2d 225, 227.
