MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Heather Rowe appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Warren, J.*) entered after a jury trial finding Rowe guilty of operating a vehicle without a license (Class E), 29-A M.R.S. § 1251(1)(A) (2010). On appeal, Rowe does not seriously contest the facts leading to the conviction, instead asserting that: (1) the court lacked authority to hear the case; (2) the prosecutors lacked the authority to prosecute her; and (3) the court, because of its rulings adverse to her point of view, should have recused.

The evidence that Rowe was operating without a license that was presented at trial is sufficient to support the jury's verdict. *See State v. Milliken*, 2010 ME 1, ¶ 19, 985 A.2d 1152, 1158. Rowe's remaining arguments regarding the court's authority, the prosecutor's credentials, and the trial judge's action in declining to recuse are frivolous and similar in nature to arguments we addressed and rejected in *State v. Murphy*, 2010 ME 140, 10 A.3d 697.
