MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David E. Catlett appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Presque Isle, *O'Mara, J.*) entered upon David's motion to modify and Carla M. Catlett's motion to enforce the parties' divorce judgment, and upon David's subsequent motion for findings of fact and conclusions of law. *See* M.R. Civ. P. 52. Contrary to David's contentions, the court did not err or abuse its discretion in reaching its factual findings, *see Pettinelli v. Yost*, 2007 ME 121, ¶ 11, 930 A.2d 1074, 1077; *see also Dargie v. Dargie*, 2001 ME 127, ¶ 19, 778 A.2d 353, 358 (affirming a divorce court's refusal to speculate about future income); in weighing the statutory factors to arrive at its spousal support determination, *see* 19-A M.R.S. § 951-A(5) (2010); *Coppola v. Coppola*, 2007 ME 147, ¶ 23, 938 A.2d 786, 793; *Pettinelli*, 2007 ME 121, ¶ 11, 930 A.2d at 1077-78; or in limiting David's cross-examination of Carla based on the issues defined in the court's pre-trial conference, *see* M.R. Civ. P. 16A(c), (d).
