MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Peter J. Jensen appeals the District Court's (Bridgton, *Moskowitz, J.*) order of sale of his real property pursuant to 14 M.R.S. § 3131(2) (2011) to satisfy a money judgment against him in favor of Bangor Savings Bank. Contrary to Jensen's contention, the District Court did not err by applying section 3131(2) and ordering the sale, regardless of the extent to which other creditors may have claims to the property. *See* 14 M.R.S. § 3131(2); *Odell v. Dunn*, 591 A.2d 465, 466 (Me. 1991). Jensen's other contentions are without merit and require no further discussion.
