MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Marek A. Kwasnik appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Wheeler, J.*) denying Kwasnik's request for a jury trial and otherwise affirming the forcible entry and detainer judgment entered by the District Court (Bridgton, *Eggert, J.*). On appeal, Kwasnik contends that he was entitled to a jury trial in this matter and that the Superior Court's affirmance of the District Court judgment was otherwise erroneous for several reasons. This property was subject to a previous forcible entry and detainer judgment affirmed by this Court in *Karnes v. Kwasnik*, Mem-11-180 (Nov. 29, 2011). As in that case, Kwasnik has not demonstrated any entitlement to a jury trial or other error of law in the judgments entered by the District Court and, on appeal, by the Superior Court.
