MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Robert Bill appeals from a divorce judgment entered in the District Court (Springvale, *Brodrick, J.*). Contrary to his contentions, the court did not violate due process or abuse its discretion in admitting and considering evidence from the guardian ad litem, *see* 19-A M.R.S. § 1507(5) (2011); M.R. Evid. 806; *cf. Ziehm v. Ziehm*, 433 A.2d 725, 729 (Me. 1981); and did not commit clear error in its factual findings or abuse its discretion in determining parental rights and responsibilities, child support, spousal support, attorney fees, and guardian ad litem fees, *see* 19-A M.R.S. §§ 1653(2)(C), 2001(5)(E) (2011); 22 M.R.S. § 4002(6)(A) (2011); *Theberge v. Theberge*, 2010 ME 132, ¶ 18, 9 A.3d 809.
