MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Aedan B. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, Mulhern, J.) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055 (2011). Contrary to the mother's contentions, there is competent evidence in the record to support the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of the mother's unfitness as a parent and that the termination of her parental rights was in the best interest of the child.
