MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Mykel Tuttle appeals from a judgment of the District Court (West Bath, *Tucker, J.*) entered in favor of Alexander Clark on his complaint for protection from harassment filed on behalf of Clark's then two-and-a-half-year-old son. *See* 5 M.R.S. § 4655 (2011). Contrary to Tuttle's contention, there was sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's order granting protection from harassment against Tuttle on behalf of the child. *See* 5 M.R.S. §§ 4651(2)(A), (C), 4655 (2011); *Sutherland v. Morrill*, 2008 ME 6, ¶¶ 4-5, 940 A.2d 192; *Wiley v. Wiley*, 2006 ME 45, ¶ 9, 896 A.2d 263. Additionally, Tuttle's contention that he was not afforded due process is without merit. *See Jusseaume v. Ducatt*, 2011 ME 43, ¶ 12, 15 A.3d 714; *State v. Tuplin*, 2006 ME 83, ¶ 22, 901 A.2d 792.
