MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Robert Price Jr. appeals from a judgment of conviction for theft by unauthorized taking or transfer (Class C), 17-A M.R.S. § 353(1)(A), (B)(4) (2012), and eluding an officer (Class C), 29-A M.R.S. § 2414(3) (2012), entered in the trial court (*Wheeler, J.*) on a jury verdict. Contrary to Price's contention, viewed in the light most favorable to the State, there is ample evidence in the record on which a reasonable jury could find, beyond a reasonable doubt, that Price committed each element of both crimes. See 17-A M.R.S. § 57(1), (2)(C), (3)(A) (2012); *State v. Reed*, 2013 ME 5, ¶ 9, 58 A.3d 1130.
