MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Timothy Gousse appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Murphy*, *J.*) awarding Chambers Leasing damages in the amount of \$37,500 plus costs and attorney fees on its complaint against Gousse for breach of contract and injunctive relief. There is neither a transcript nor a rule 5(d) statement in this case. *See* M.R. App. P. 5(d). Given the state of the record, we cannot discern any legal error in the court's interpretation of the documents, nor are we persuaded, as Gousse argues, that the geographic restriction was unreasonable. *See Guardianship of Helen F.*, 2013 ME 18, ¶ 6, 60 A.3d 786; *Sisters of Charity Health Sys. v. Farrago*, 2011 ME 62, ¶ 10, 21 A.3d 110; *Verizon New Eng., Inc. v. Pub. Utils. Comm'n*, 2005 ME 16, ¶ 15, 866 A.2d 844. Additionally, we cannot determine, as Gousse contends, that the court erred in finding that Gousse breached the non-competition agreement or in admitting the contested parts of Scott Lanpher's testimony. *See Guardianship of Helen F.*, 2013 ME 18, ¶ 6, --- A.3d ---; *Jefts v. Dennis*, 2007 ME 129, ¶ 7, 931 A.2d 1055.
