MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jorge Tavares appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Ellsworth, Mallonee, J.) awarding Brenda Gove possession of several items of personal property, including a tractor and woodstove. See 14 M.R.S. § 7071 (2012). Contrary to Tavares's contentions, (1) the court did not err or abuse its discretion in awarding Gove possession of a tractor to which Tavares held title, see id.; cf. State v. One Blue Corvette, 1999 ME 98, ¶ 13 & n. 9, 732 A.2d 856 (noting that possessory rights in a vehicle may belong to someone other than the title holder); (2) no unconstitutional taking was effected through the transfer of possession to Gove because the court determined, based on competent evidence in the record, that Gove—not Tavares—held the right of possession, see Weinstein v. Hurlbert, 2012 ME 84, ¶ 9, 45 A.3d 743; cf. Blanchard v. Dep't of Transp., 2002 ME 96, ¶ 28, 798 A.2d 1119 (requiring the owner's consent for the government to take private property for private use); and (3) in the absence of a motion for additional findings, see M.R. Civ. P. 52(a), we infer that the court made all findings, supported by the record, that were necessary to support its award of the woodstove to Gove, see Weinstein, 2012 ME 84, ¶ 9, 45 A.3d 743.
