MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kevin Tracy appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Biddeford, *Janelle, J.*) adjudicating him of committing the civil offense of dog at large, 7 M.R.S. § 3911 (2013). Contrary to Tracy's contention, the evidence, viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for the court to find each element of the offense by a preponderance of the evidence. *See State v. Peck*, 2014 ME 74, ¶ 13, 93 A.3d 256.
