MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of A.T., R.S., R.S., and A.S. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Lewiston, *Beliveau, J.*) ordering termination of her parental rights to the children pursuant to the Child and Family Service and Child Protection Act, 22 M.R.S § 4055(1)(B) (2013). Contrary to the mother's contentions, when reviewed for clear error, the evidence was sufficient for the trial judge to order termination of parental rights. *See In re Heather G.*, 2002 ME 151, ¶ 12, 805 A.2d 249.
