MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of J.C. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Rockland, *Sparaco*, *J*.) terminating her parental rights to her child pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(A)(1)(a), (1)(B)(2) (2013). Contrary to the mother's contention, the court did not err in finding by clear and convincing evidence at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination of her parental rights was in the child's best interest, and did not err in applying the provisions of 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2). *See In re Scott S.*, 2001 ME 114, ¶¶ 19-21, 775 A.2d 1144; *In re M.B.*, 2013 ME 46, ¶ 37, 65 A.3d 1260; *In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶¶ 14, 18-21, 802 A.2d 976.
