MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Stephen S. Smith appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Ellsworth, *Mallonee, J.*) imposing a fine on Smith after finding that he violated 29-A M.R.S. § 1768(5) (2013) by operating a defective motor vehicle. Contrary to Smith's contention, the court did not err in finding that Smith's vehicle was defective under both the partial vehicle inspection rules and the full vehicle inspection rules. *See* 29-A M.R.S. §§ 1751-1752 (2013); 9 C.M.R. 16 222 001-13 § 170 (2012).
