MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Sloan H. Smith appeals from a judgment of conviction entered in the District Court (Ellsworth, *Mallonee, J.*) upon her conditional guilty plea to operating under the influence (Class D) (OUI), 29-A M.R.S. § 2411(1-A)(B)(1) (2013), following the denial of her motion to suppress evidence. Contrary to Smith's contentions, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the District Court's decision, was sufficient for the court to conclude that the officer had an objectively reasonable, articulable suspicion that justified the stop of Smith's vehicle. See *State v. Connor*, 2009 ME 91, ¶¶ 9, 11, 977 A.2d 1103, *State v. Porter*, 2008 ME 175, ¶¶ 11-12, 960 A.2d 321; *State v. LaForge*, 2012 ME 65, ¶¶ 10, 13, 43 A.3d 961.
