MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of A.D., R.M., and S.M. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Portland, *Goranites, J.*) terminating his parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2013). Contrary to the father's contention, competent evidence exists in the record to support the court's findings that the Department of Health and Human Services established by clear and convincing evidence at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination of the father's parental rights is in the best interest of the children. *See id.*; *In re M.S.*, 2014 ME 54, ¶¶ 13, 15, 90 A.3d 443.
