MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of C.D. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Biddeford, *Foster, J.*) finding that the child was in circumstances of jeopardy pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4035 (2013). Contrary to the father's contention, the evidence was sufficient for the court to make the required finding by a preponderance of the evidence. *Id.*; see *In re M.E.*, 2014 ME 98, ¶ 16, 97 A.3d 1082.
