MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of I.J. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Goranites, J.*) terminating her parental rights to the child on the petition of the Department of Health and Human Services. Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record contains sufficient competent evidence to support the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination is in the best interest of the child. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2014); *In re M.S.*, 2014 ME 54, ¶¶ 13, 15, 90 A.3d 443.
