MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Theodore W. Thomes appeals from an order of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Wheeler, J.*) denying his motion to set aside an entry of default, pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 55(c), and his motion for relief from judgment, pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 60(b). Contrary to Thomes's contention, the court did not abuse its discretion in finding that Thomes had not satisfied his burden of proving good cause in order to set aside the entry of default or excusable neglect so as to vacate the default judgment. *See Dyer Goodall & Federle, LLC v. Proctor*, 2007 ME 145, ¶ 18, 935 A.2d 1123; *Maroon Flooring, Inc. v. Austin*, 2007 ME 75, ¶ 9, 927 A.2d 1182; *Begin v. Jerry's Sunoco, Inc.*, 435 A.2d 1079, 1083 (Me. 1981); *Porges v. Reid*, 423 A.2d 542, 544-45 (Me. 1980).
