MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of M.T. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Lewiston, *Beliveau*, J.) terminating her parental rights to her child pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(A)(1)(a), (1)(B)(2) (2013). Contrary to the mother's contention, the court did not err in finding by clear and convincing evidence at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination of her parental rights was in the child's best interest. *See In re Robert S.*, 2009 ME 18, ¶ 15, 966 A.2d 894; *In re A.M.*, 2012 ME 118, ¶¶ 29, 31, 55 A.3d 463.
