MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The parents of R.W. appeal from a judgment entered in the District Court (Springvale, *Foster*, *J*.) terminating each parent's parental rights to the child pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(A)(1)(a), (B)(2) (2013). Contrary to the parents' contentions, the record supports the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness as to each parent. *See In re J.R. Jr.*, 2013 ME 58, ¶ 15, 69 A.3d 406. The court also did not err or abuse its discretion in determining that termination of both parents' parental rights is in the child's best interests. *See In re C.P.*, 2013 ME 57, ¶¶ 16-17, 67 A.3d 558.
