MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of S.K. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Goranites, J.*) terminating his parental rights to the child pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2013). Contrary to the father's contentions, there was ample evidence in the record, as a matter of fact and law, to support the court's finding, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination of the father's rights is in the best interest of the child. *See In re M.B.*, 2013 ME 46, ¶ 37, 65 A.3d 1260.
