MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Paul Cancelarich appeals from a divorce judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Powers, J.*), challenging the judgment's child support, spousal support, marital property, marital debt, and attorney fees provisions. After reviewing the well-written opinion, with its very helpful chart of assets, we conclude that the court did not abuse its discretion in (1) determining the parties' earning capacities or declining to impute income to Lila Cancelarich in order to calculate Paul's child support obligation, *see Carolan v. Bell*, 2007 ME 39, ¶¶ 19-21, 916 A.2d 945; *Dargie v. Dargie*, 2001 ME 127, ¶ 19, 778 A.2d 353; (2) awarding Lila spousal support, *see Carter v. Carter*, 2006 ME 68, ¶¶ 19-20, 900 A.2d 200; *Sorey v. Sorey*, 1998 ME 217, ¶¶ 10-14, 718 A.2d 568; (3) excluding certain family "loans" from its calculation of marital debt and otherwise dividing the marital estate, *see Thumith v. Thumith*, 2013 ME 67, ¶¶ 8-10, 70 A.3d 1232; *Doughty v. Sullivan*, 661 A.2d 1112, 1123 (Me. 1995); or (4) ordering Paul to pay a portion of Lila's attorney fees, *see Carter*, 2006 ME 68, ¶ 23, 900 A.2d 200; *Rosen v. Rosen*, 651 A.2d 335, 336-37 (Me. 1994).
