MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of C.K. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Rumford, *Carlson, J.*) finding that the child would be placed in jeopardy if placed in the father's custody. *See* 22 M.R.S. §§ 4002(6), 4035 (2013). Contrary to the father's contentions, the record supports the court's finding of jeopardy by a preponderance of the evidence. *See In re Destiny T.*, 2009 ME 26, ¶ 14, 965 A.2d 872.
