MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of S.C. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Powers, J.*) terminating his parental rights to the child. Contrary to the father's contention, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination is in the best interest of the child. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2014); *In re B.P.*, 2015 ME 139, ¶¶ 16, 19, --- A.3d ---.
