MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of T.T. and J.T. appeals from a judgment terminating her parental rights to the children entered in the District Court (Farmington, *Carlson, J.*). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the court critically assessed the evidence, *see In re Heather G.*, 2002 ME 151, ¶¶ 9-11, 805 A.2d 249, and competent evidence in the record supports the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination is in the best interests of the children. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a), (b)(ii) (2014).
