MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Douglas and Bertha Grover appeal from a judgment of the Superior Court (Oxford County, *Clifford, J.*) awarding civil penalties, attorney fees, and costs to the Town of Greenwood pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. §§ 3758-A(3), 4452(3) (2014), and a subsequent order denying their motion to alter or amend the judgment pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 59(e). Contrary to the Grovers' contentions, the court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion in granting civil penalties, *see Town of Levant v. Seymour*, 2004 ME 115, ¶ 29, 855 A.2d 1159, or in granting attorney fees and costs to the Town as the prevailing party, *see Town of China v. Althenn*, 2013 ME 107, ¶ 14, 82 A.2d 835.
