MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother and father of S.V. and I.V. appeal from a judgment terminating their parental rights to the children entered in the District Court (Springvale, *Foster, J.*). Contrary to the mother's and father's contentions, competent evidence in the record supports the court's determination, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness as to each parent and that termination is in the best interests of the children. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2014); *In re Doris G.*, 2006 ME 142, ¶¶ 17-18, 912 A.2d 572.
