MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of T.S. and S.F. appeals from two judgments terminating her parental rights to the children entered in the District Court (Lewiston, *Schneider, J.*). Contrary to the mother's contentions, competent evidence in the record supports the court's determination, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination is in the best interest of the children. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2014); *In re M.S.*, 2014 ME 54, ¶¶ 13-15, 90 A.3d 443.
