## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of C.L. and E.L. appeals from a jeopardy order entered by the District Court (Dover-Foxcroft, *Stitham*, *J.*) giving custody of the children to the Department of Health and Human Services pursuant to 22 M.R.S. §§ 4035-36. Contrary to the mother's contentions, the evidence admitted at the hearing was sufficient to support the court's finding of jeopardy and to award custody to the Department. *See In re B.C.*, 2012 ME 140, ¶ 11, 58 A.3d 1118.
