#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Frank Drew appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Belfast, *Worth, J.*) denying his motion to modify parental rights and responsibilities. Contrary to Drew's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion when it denied the father's request that it hear testimony from the parties' two teenage children. *See Nadeau v. Nadeau*, 2008 ME 147, ¶ 29, 957 A.2d 108. Additionally, the court did not abuse its discretion in applying the best interest of the child standard. *See Grant v. Hamm*, 2012 ME 79, ¶ 6, 48 A.3d 789.
