MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of A.C. appeals from a jeopardy order entered against him in the District Court (West Bath, *Dobson*, *J.*) pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4035 (2014). Contrary to the father's contentions, competent evidence in the record supported the court's factual findings by a preponderance of the evidence, that the father placed the child in jeopardy. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4002(6) (2014); *In re M.E.*, 2014 ME 98, ¶ 16, 97 A.3d 1082. The father's remaining contentions are also unpersuasive. *See In re Misty B.*, 2000 ME 67, ¶¶ 8-9, 749 A.2d 754.
