MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of N.D. and A.D. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Powers*, *J.*) terminating her parental rights to her children pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1) (2014). Contrary to the mother's contention, there was sufficient evidence from which the court could have found by clear and convincing evidence that at least one ground of parental unfitness existed despite adequate rehabilitation and reunification services provided by the Department, and that termination of the mother's parental rights was in the children's best interests.
