MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David M. Hussey appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Biddeford, *Driscoll, J.*) modifying his parental rights and responsibilities. Contrary to Hussey's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion in granting the motion to modify. *See Grant v. Hamm*, 2012 ME 79, ¶ 6, 48 A.3d 789. Additionally, because no party raised the issues regarding child support in the trial court, those issues have not been preserved for appeal. *See Akers v. Akers*, 2012 ME 75, ¶ 9, 44 A.3d 311.
