MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Rhonda Totman-Berube appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Murphy, J.*), affirming the decision of the Maine Public Employees Retirement System Board of Trustees to deny her application for disability retirement benefits. *See* 5 M.R.S. §§ 17921-17934 (2014). Contrary to her contention, the record did not compel the Board to conclude that she was qualified to receive such benefits. *See Kelley v. Me. Pub. Emps. Ret. Sys.*, 2009 ME 27, ¶ 16, 967 A.2d 676.
