MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

John V. Dickey appeals from a judgment of conviction of criminal OUI, 29-A M.R.S. § 2411(1-A)(C)(1) (2014), entered upon a jury verdict in the Unified Criminal Docket (Hancock County, *Mallonee, J.*). Contrary to Dickey's contention, there was sufficient evidence to support the jury's finding that Dickey was under the influence of intoxicants at the time he operated the motor vehicle. *See State v. McCurdy*, 2002 ME 66, ¶¶ 10-11, 795 A.2d 84.
