MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kevin Collins appeals from an order of the Superior Court (Somerset County, *Mullen, J.*) dismissing his Freedom of Access Act claim against Kennebec County Jail for failure to prosecute within two years pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 41(b). Collins did not take any action with regard to his FOAA claim against the Jail between September 21, 2012, and March 4, 2015, when the Jail filed its motion to dismiss. For this reason, we affirm the court's dismissal.
