MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Carol Fogg, also known as Carol Fletcher, appeals from a judgment of the York County Probate Court (*Nadeau, J.*) adjudicating her incapacitated and appointing the Department of Health and Human Services as her public guardian, without limitation. *See* 18-A M.R.S. §§ 5-101(1), 5-304(b), 5-601 (2015). Contrary to Fogg's contentions, the evidence presented at trial supports the court's finding that she is incapacitated as defined by section 5-101(1). *See Guardianship of McIntosh*, 2015 ME 95, ¶ 16, 120 A.3d 654. Further, the court did not abuse its discretion by appointing the Department as Fogg's full guardian, without limitation. *See In re Cyr*, 2005 ME 61, ¶ 16, 873 A.2d 355; *cf. Guardianship of Hughes*, 1998 ME 186, ¶ 17, 715 A.2d 919.
