MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The Raisin Memorial Trust appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Cole, C.J.*) calculating attorney fees and expenses owed by the Trust to the law firm of Kelly, Rummel & Zimmerman (KRZ) on KRZ's claim for fraudulent transfer. Contrary to the Trust's contention, and given the Trust's failure to challenge with particularity any of the fees or expenses sought by KRZ, we discern no clear error or abuse of discretion in the court's calculation of the amount owed by the Trust. See 14 M.R.S. § 3578(1)(C)(3) (2015); *Roussel v. Ashby*, 2015 ME 43, ¶ 10, 114 A.3d 670; *Samsara Mem'l Trust v. Kelly, Rummel & Zimmerman*, 2014 ME 107, ¶ 48, 102 A.3d 757; *Mancini v. Scott*, 2000 ME 19, ¶ 10, 744 A.2d 1057.
