MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother and father of Mia R. appeal from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Eggert, J.*) terminating their parental rights. Contrary to the parents' contentions, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination is in the best interest of the child. *See* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2015); *In re M.S.*, 2014 ME 54, ¶ 13, 90 A.3d 443.
