MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother and father of Alexander O. and Athena O. appeal from a judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Jordan, J.*) terminating their parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2015). Contrary to the parents' contentions, there is sufficient competent evidence in the record on which the court could find, by the clear and convincing standard, at least one ground of parental unfitness, and that termination of their parental rights is in the best interest of the children. *See In re C.A.*, 2015 ME 34, ¶¶ 12-13, 113 A.3d 1098.
